



New proposals in Congress threaten human life, the family, and religious freedom.





### **Holy Trinity's Organ Restoration Project Begins**

Donations now being accepted, pledge cards are available

A letter from our pastor, Fr. Tony Fortman, C.PP.S., was sent to all registered parishioners early this week. Our goal is to raise \$100,000 over one year. Included in the letter was a pledge card and return envelope for consideration to support this fund drive.

If you did not receive Father's letter but wish to support this effort, there are pledge cards and envelopes on the tables at the entrance to each aisle. Mr. Nicholas Koch has been working on our organ for over a year and there is still much to do. We appreciate your help.

Our organ contains some of the oldest pipes in the City of Dayton. Koehnken & Co built the first organ installed in 1861 when the church was built. Our current organ was built by the Wangerin Weickhardt Company in 1919, and some of the pipes from the 1861 organ are still in use today. The immediate repairs are estimated at \$100,000 and include rebuilding the "Echo" organ behind the altar, rebuilding the Pedal Division, and relocating and replacing the motor/blower. The repairs are critical to ensure the continued presence of music for Mass and other services.


