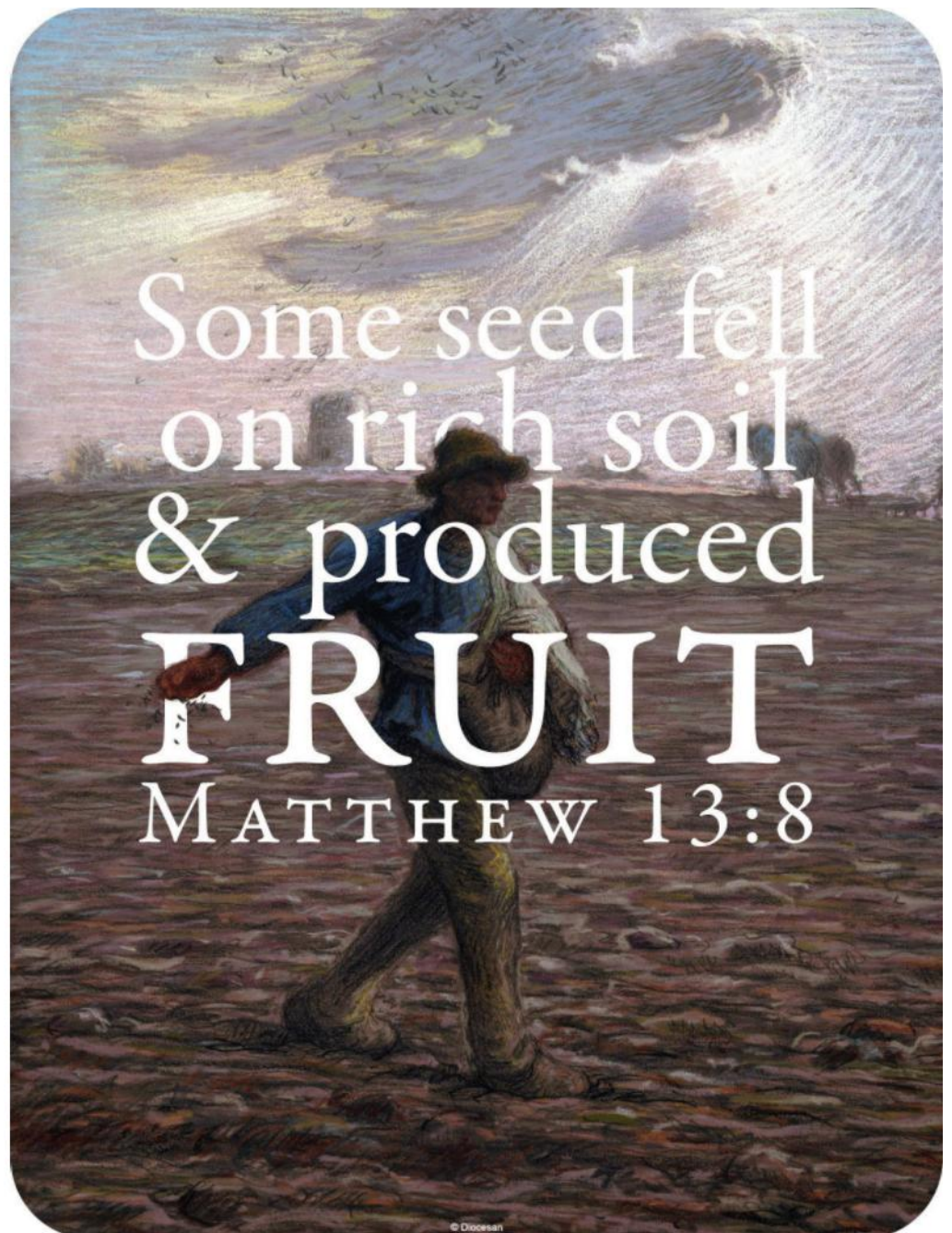

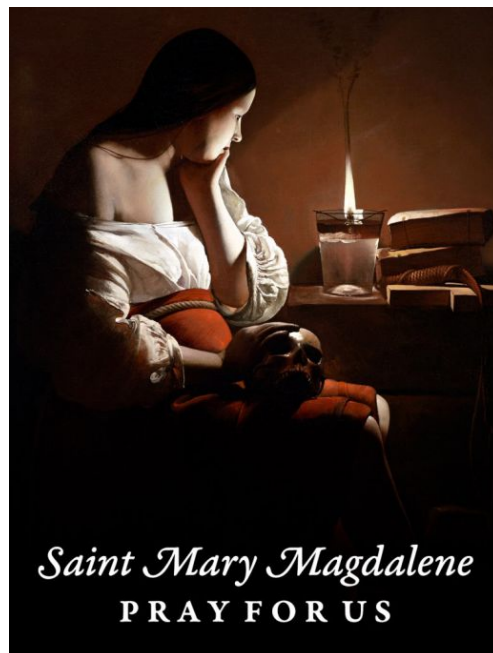

The Archdiocese of Cincinnati has updated and issued the new Child Protection Decree. All volunteers who work with children, youth, and vulnerable adults must do the following:

- Log on to your Safe Parish
- Go to your Dashboard and click on Decree
- Download and save the Decree to your computer
- Formally Acknowledge receipt of the Decree

This Decree is important, it details the revised procedures, regulations, and protocols for all parishes, schools, and institutions of the Archdiocese on how we all will protect, nurture, and promote the safety, well-being, and protection of our children, youth, and vulnerable adults.. In addition, the new video, quarterly Safe Parish bulletin is posted to your individual accounts. The deadline to complete and answer all questions is Wednesday, July 19th. If you need assistance logging into your SafeParish account contact your local administrator.
